a)	Holds a valid Bell Diving Supervisor Certificate and letter of appointment	
b)	Can demonstrate a basic knowledge of DP systems and vessel/site specific manoeuvring restrictions	
c)	Can prepare and execute safe and effective dive plans, risk assessments and work procedures	
d)	Can safely operate the sat control dive panels whilst maintaining supervisory control of the sat diving operations, including bell handling systems and diving bells	
e)	Can supervise the safe deployment and recovery of the bell and divers to and from worksite, including lost bell procedures	
f)	Can maintain suitable, clear and precise records/logs relating to dive operations	
g)	Can communicate effectively with colleagues	
h)	Can communicate effectively with sat control, direct deck and marine personnel	
i)	Can demonstrate effective leadership techniques in the workplace and offers guidance where necessary	
j)	Does not take unacceptable risks and is able to identify the requirement for the management of change and its implementation	
k)	Can demonstrate a good standard of personal tidiness and hygiene in the workplace	
l)	Can effectively supervise all relevant operational and equipment maintenance requirements where appropriate	
m)	Can effectively manage and control all project equipment and tooling used or deployed during project/diving activities
