c)	Knows and can supervise procedures to be followed during an emergency which will affect the system and/or personnel within	
d)	Can locate alarms and describe how they are activated in the event of an emergency	
e)	Can demonstrate an awareness of their role and that of other members of the Dive Technical Team and 'others' during emergency procedures	
f)	Can locate company documentation which is relevant to emergencies including contingency procedures	
g)	Can brief the team on the actions that must be taken when system contingencies are required to be instigated e.g. loss of video, loss of system power or entanglement
