	Performance Criteria	Type of Evidence
a)	For Operators of Offshore Certified Cranes they have successfully completed an appropriate Offshore Crane Operator Training (as appropriate to the crane activities performed)	
b)	Has successfully completed appropriate training courses including Manual Handling, Working at Heights	
c)	Demonstrates the safe and efficient operation of cranes to handle; cargoes - vessel to vessel and vessel to shore, heavy loads, subsea equipment lifts	
d)	Demonstrates the safe and efficient use of rigging appliances	
e)	Demonstrates appropriate communications techniques during lifting operations	
f)	Demonstrates a good shift handover to the next Crane Operator and/or Deck Foreman (oral and written)	
g)	Demonstrates a high level of safety awareness and is aware of hazards involved in lifting operations and takes measures to reduce risks	
h)	Demonstrates the ability to remain calm when working in high pressure/stressful situations and knows when to call time out for safety	
i)	Demonstrates appropriate actions in response to emergency situations, including seeking assistance, notifying line management and following company reporting requirements	
j)	Demonstrates an understanding of how changing weather and environmental conditions will affect lifting operations	
k)	Anticipates unsafe conditions and anticipates adverse weather during work operations and informs line management	
l)	Maintains the Crane Safety Logbook	
m)	Maintains an IMCA Crane Operators Logbook	
n)	Demonstrates adequate technical knowledge of cranes and reports faults and maintenance requirements of crane and/or lifting equipment to line management	
o)	Demonstrates awareness of the effects of dynamic motion of vessels on lifts and its potential effects with subsea equipment and diving personnel
