a)	Demonstrates the ability to assist with preventative maintenance tasks on the ROV, TMS and LARS, including preparing the work area and tools required.	
b)	Demonstrates the ability to assist with fault finding tasks on the ROV, TMS and LARS, including locating any procedures and fault reporting documents.	
c)	Demonstrates the ability to assist with ROV system pre & post dive checks, including powering up / powering down the ROV system.	
d)	Demonstrates the ability to assist with ROV launch and recovery operations.	
e)	Demonstrates the ability to assist with ROV piloting and co-piloting. Including the use of compass, depth control, altitude control, turns counters, cameras and data recorders.	
f)	Demonstrates the ability to assist with the use of sonar, positioning systems and other navigation aids.	
g)	Demonstrates the ability to assist with log keeping, maintenance record keeping and other routine administration to support ROV operations.	
h)	Demonstrates the ability to respond correctly to system alarms and indications that are out of tolerance.	
i)	Demonstrates the ability to assist with the maintenance, testing & operating of topside & subsea tooling equipment.	
j)	Demonstrates the ability to assist with the pre-use inspection & operation of lifting equipment
